Child Protection/ Safeguarding Children

Can we remind parents about 'The Underwear Rule'? (see poster below) The NSPCC have a resource which can help parents and carers talk to their children about staying safe and preventing abuse. The guide outlines how you can have simple, age appropriate conversations with your 5 -11 year old child. It teaches them that their body belongs to them, they have a right to say "no", and that they should tell an adult if they are upset or worried. **Please discuss this 'PANTS' poster with your child.** Each line of PANTS covers a different part of the Underwear Rule. How and when you talk PANTS to your child is your choice. After all, you know them better than anyone. You'll

know when they're ready and how much detail to go into.

There is also a 'Tell Someone You Trust' video on YouTube, which explains to children what sexual abuse and exploitation are. It has been made by children for children aged from around Key Stage 2/P5 and above. We would highly recommend that you, as a parent watch this valuable resource first and then decide if you wish your child to view it.
